

Did you Know?

- 24% (10,293) of those who moved to Harris County are from the State of California, whereas only 17% from Harris County (5,579) moved out to the same State.
- Louisiana gained 7,977 people from Harris County and lost 8,420
- 5% and less are from the States of Colorado, Oklahoma, and Alaska.
- Overall, Harris County's most net gain is 14,387 persons, of which 33% (4,714) are from California, followed by 13% (1,845) from Alaska State and 11% (1,618) from New York State.
- 5% and less gain received from the States of Tennessee, Georgia, South Carolina and Illinois.





Note: County-to-County Migration data is collected by American Community Survey between 2008 and 2012 to show how many residents move from one specific county to another, during the course of a year

The data shows the origin and destination of people 16 years and older by their most recent primary occupation during the same period.

Only the top ten states (of inflow to Harris County) are considered for the analysis.
