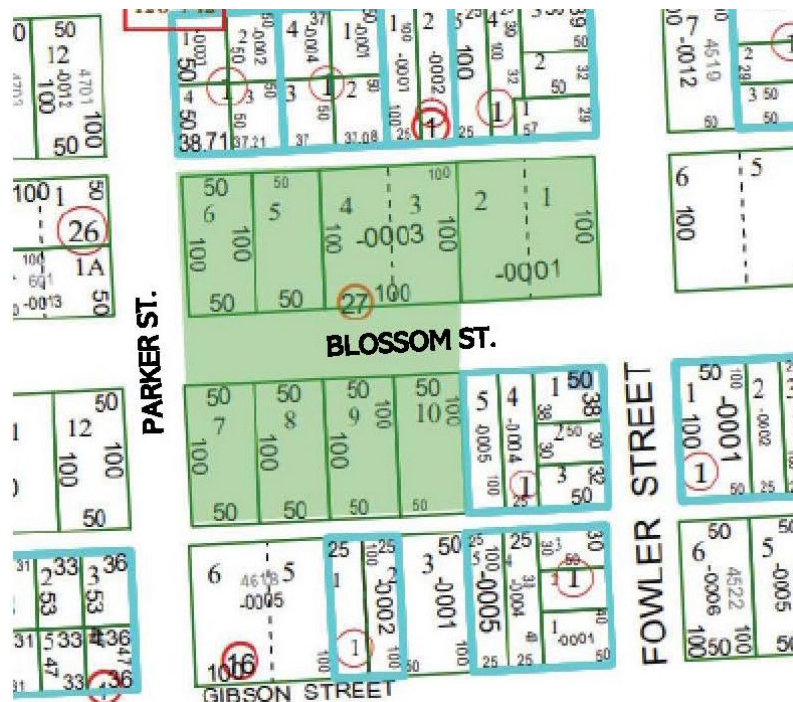


Figure 1-District Proposed for Shaded Area
