







- Reclassify Greenbriar Drive from University to S. Main on the hierarchy table from a 4 lane to 2 lane major thoroughfare.

Justification

- Greenbriar is currently designated as Thoroughfare: T-4-60
- Greenbriar is approximately
 - 1 mile from University to S. Main Street
 - 3 miles within the City Limits
- Greenbriar is a thoroughfare that travels from US 59 to Fannin Street. The thoroughfare connects US 59 to the Rice Village/Rice University area and to Fannin south connecting to IH 610.



Justification

- Current volume is 19,182 ADT for 2011 and is projected to be 22,224 ADT for 2035.
- Basis for the recommendation is the outcome from Pre-Engineering under the ReBuild Houston program and public engagement process.
