# From the Director

Each month, the Office of Planning & Data Governance publishes a Crime by Council District Monthly Update. The report is intended to inform City Council members about crime in their districts. The report provides a snapshot of verified crime totals from the previous month, grouped by each Council District. The report reflects official offense counts submitted by Records Division to the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) via the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS). The accuracy rate for assigning crime to council districts is ~99%; the ~1% error is due to missing or incomplete address information.

This report is released between the 15th and 25th of the following month to allow time for the NIBRS validation, submission, and approval processes. These processes are necessary to ensure the accuracy and reliability of the data contained in the report.

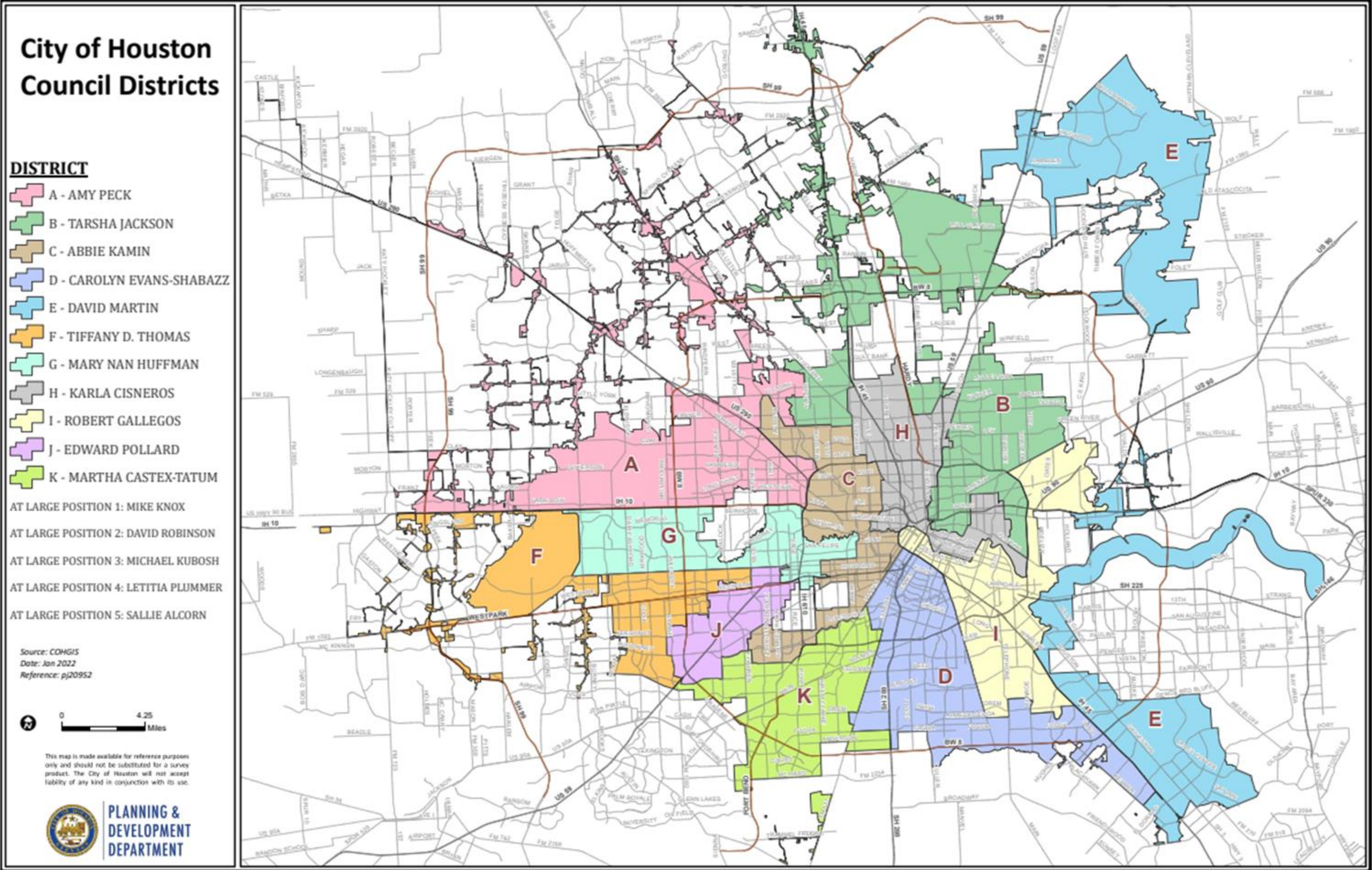
