HPD Takes Stand Against Domestic Violence

October 31, 2015

October is Domestic Violence Awareness Month. The Houston Police Department seeks to reduce domestic violence through a three-fold approach: it trains police personnel, it educates the public and it investigates domestic violence crimes.

The Houston Police Department has provided nearly 6000 purple wristband with "Houston Police Domestic Violence Awareness" printed on them to patrol officers. Also, the Houston Police Department has provided the purple wristband to the cadets at the start of their career with the important message of domestic violence awareness and encouraging victims of domestic violence to speak out.
